We're pleased to announce that in our continuing effort to enhance your quality of life, the Town of Cary is moving forward with an \$8 million project to improve the pavement conditions of most of Cary Parkway south of High House Road. Rea Contracting of Raleigh will be conducting the work, which is set to begin in March and last through the fall.

We know how important this roadway is to you and so many who travel in and through Cary each day, which is why we've instructed the contractor to do everything possible to keep at least one travel lane in each direction open during the project.
