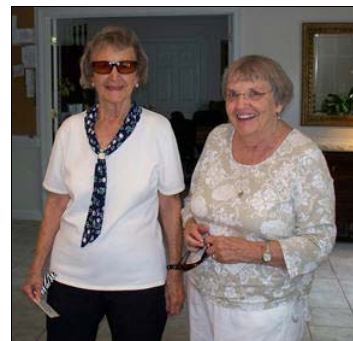

A Hot Summer

We are living through a hot summer and the weather is not very friendly to our grass; it is obvious that our grass is stressed.

Weeds will grow and flourish under the most stressed conditions and we can see that in Troon. During the hot weather months of June, July, and August, the grass will be mowed every other week to reduce some of the stress on the grass. Emphasis will be placed on weed control.

Several residences have overgrown shrubbery, especially around windows, and the landscaping contractor has been notified to trim these shrubs. The Landscape Committee will monitor that this gets it done.

We are aware of the problems and working to correct them to improve the appearance of Troon.

Water Heater Expansion Tank

We have recently had three reports from residents of water leaks coming from the expansion tanks installed over the hot water tanks. All were small pin holes, but water was coming out of the tanks under pressure.

We strongly recommend that residents check their water tanks for leaks and check at least monthly.

There should be a water shutoff valve at the hot water tank, one in the garage or in your house (pantry or closet), and at the water meter. Locate all three, so when and if you have a water leak, you can shut off the water quickly to minimize the damage.

Ladies Exercise and Water Aerobics



For the months of July, and August, ladies' exercise will be held at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays in the clubhouse and water aerobics will be at 4:00 p.m. on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

Landscape Committee

The extended summer heat has taken its toll on our lawns once again. No amount of sprinkling or rain can keep the grass from burning, so for the next few months, we will have to put up with it.

The sprinkler system continues to give us problems. Maintenance is an on going concern, with around \$3000.00 being spent already this year on parts and labor to keep it running.



In the last several months a lot of overgrown shrubs have been removed around Troon Village. We are far from being done on this project, and replanting new, smaller, drought resistant bushes will be completed in the fall.

The Boy Scout project around the pond area, including benches, a picnic table, and a rail fence on the west end has been completed.

It is official now, the addition of new pine straw around our buildings has been banned by the Town of Cary, due to fire hazards. The new rule mentions pine straw cannot be used within 10 feet from any wood or vinyl structures, including windows and soffits. We have about nine or ten months to decide what ground cover will be used in place of the existing pine straw. Several Cary communities have already gone to bug treated mulch, which has been approved by Cary and can be added on top of the decaying pine straw base. This may be an appropriate choice for Troon.

We are still looking into creating a three-year landscaping plan for Troon to include maintaining areas immediately around our homes, the pond area, the banks surrounding the community, as well as the entrances. It is clearly going to take additional funding to meet the expectations of our homeowners and to keep Troon looking like a first class community.

- If you encounter intruders or vandalism, call police at 911 or 469-4016
