ARCHITECTURAL & NEIGHBORHOOD GUIDELINES

Thinking about raised beds, new plantings, exterior lighting or a play house, perhaps a basketball hoop? We are an HOA neighborhood that requires exterior modifications on your property to be pre-approved by ACC. Review turnaround time has been pretty fast once all information is submitted by the homeowner.

Please go to NABR to review our Architectural Guidelines and make submissions. Feel free to email the management company (Grandchester Meadows) or ACC team if you are unsure about your project. Projects without approval may be subjected to fines/violations.

No garbage, building materials or other items are permitted on township buffer areas on Castleberry Road, Wimberly Road, and HOA common areas. Your property line is defined on your plot plan. No staging of materials in allowed on public roads and sidewalks. Our community has fully turned over now so public areas belong to township, which means that potty needs to be gone!


