OUR HOME MAINTENANCE

With spring in Holly Springs arriving, maybe sooner than we thought it would have, it is time to start our planning for outdoor work in our yards and our homes. While our winter was not too bad this year, the cold weather always takes its toll on our properties.

Please take some time and slowly walk around your yard and ask yourself; do the bushes or trees need trimming, do I need to remove the fall leaves and pine straw from the roof and gutters, time to clean up the lawnmower, maybe it's time to give the outside siding a good cleaning, remove the broken sticks to the curb for the town to pick up. Maybe the gutters need to be cleaned out - maybe the front door and/or shutters needs a fresh coat of paint - maybe the mailbox needs some attention. LANDSCAPING

Again, as most of you may have heard and have seen, we have a new landscaping company that started the first of this year.

They are in the process of performing major pruning of greenery around the pool and at the Sonic entrance of Windward Pointe. They will continue with 'touch ups' over the next month. JBH Landscaping will be putting down a layer of mulch over the next month, too.

With the Holly Springs Road widening, the road will come closer to our pool and pool house.
