HOME MAINTENANCE

QUARTERLY DUES

No one likes to write checks for their expenditures, including me, but the quarterly dues that are paid to the HOA helps keep our neighborhood looking and operating at the best that it can be. Our dues pay for the upkeep of the pool, landscaping (cutting grass, trimming trees, etc.), electricity and water, internet and telephone, insurance, general and future maintenance of the properties, our management company, social committee events and many other smaller things. So, please remember all of this when you write those checks. We cannot properly operate our neighborhood if our dues are not current.

As a reminder our HOA dues are to be paid quarterly. Payments are due by the last day of the following months - January, April, July and October. If past these dates then a late payment could be applied monthly. Additionally, pool privileges could also be removed. Please help us keep our neighborhood the best in town.

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POOL RULES

We would like to remind all of our neighbors (adults and minors) that in order for our pool to operate safely and for the enjoyment of everyone that lives in Windward Pointe, we have rules that we all need to observe. See below for a link for our rules.

Access in and out of the pool is to be via the front gate, only. The back gate is for emergency access only. No one other than WP Pool contractors should be going in or out of this gate and should be tightly closed at all times.

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WHY DID THE POOL OPEN LATE?

The old backflow valve (a backflow valve is a valve that is between our property-pool, bathrooms, etc.-and the town's main water supply. The valve will not permit contaminated water from flowing backward into the town drinking water) that was installed when the pool was first built in 1994. It was determined to be faulty and had to be replaced. We worked with the town to delay the replacement of the old valve to allow us to open the pool if the old valve tested positive, but in the end, it did not test positively.

All of this took time, arranging time with the town, lining up an inspector and then having the old valve tested twice because missing parts for the old valve, working with a utility contractor and the town to acquire permits, have the valve installed and then inspected and approved by the town. Be assured your board did everything possible to get the backflow valve replaced as quickly as we could.

The new valve has been located outside of the area where Holly Springs Road will be widened so no additional work will be needed by us.

We are required to have the backflow valve tested yearly. This will be scheduled early in the spring of each year to make sure that any issues that may come up are taken care of early so not to delay the opening of the pool.
