# **TASTY BITES: POTATO SOUP**

- Optional: If you have a ham bone, simmer in broth for 1 hour.
- Add bacon pieces to a soup pot over medium heat and cook until crisp and the fat is rendered. Remove bacon from pot and set aside. Pour off most of the grease, but do not clean the pot.
- Return pot to medium-high heat, add carrots, celery, onions. Stir and cook for about 2 minutes.
- Add potatoes, Cajun/Mesquite spice, ½ tsp salt and some pepper. Cook 5 minutes. Pour in the broth and bring to a gentle boil.
- Cook until potatoes just start to get tender, about 10 minutes. Whisk together milk and flour in separate bowl, then pour the mixture into the soup and cook for another 5 minutes.
- Remove about half the soup and blend in blender or food processor until completely smooth. Pour it back into soup pot and stir to combine. Taste for seasoning.
- Stir in the cream, then parsley. Serve in bowls and garnish with grated cheddar and crisp bacon.
- · Leftovers can be frozen.

8 cups low sodium chicken or vegetable broth

Salt and freshly ground black pepper

Please go to NABR to review our Architectural Guidelines and make submissions. Feel free to email the management company (Grandchester Meadows) or ACC team if you are unsure about your project. Projects without approval may be subjected to fines/violations.

No garbage, building materials or other items are permitted on township buffer areas on Castleberry Road, Wimberly Road, and HOA common areas. Your property line is defined on your plot plan. No staging of materials is allowed on public roads and sidewalks. Please remove any concrete blocks, wood pallets on the buffer and submit an ARC request if they are on your property.
