## Homeplace III HOA Shrub Pruning Criteria

As of September 1, 2023

The Homeplace III HOA Community has three main shrub pruning criteria in which to guide and inform shrub pruning throughout the community. These criteria are as follows:

- 1) Safety: Prune back all shrubs and vegetation that block visibility of road and parking lot entries/exits; intrude onto sidewalks, walkways, and steps; block windows (trim to at least ½ visibility); handrail clearance to include visibility of unit numbers, make contact with street lights or electric wiring, and low hanging shrub limbs over sidewalks and parking spaces by at least 1/3.
- 2) HOA Maintenance: Prune back all shrubs and vegetation that make contact with townhome roofs, exterior walls, windows and front handrails by one-third.
- 3) Aesthetics: Prune back all shrubs with overgrowth in relation to shrub type, location, proximity to buildings, purpose or function (e.g., hedges vs stand-alone) by one-third. In addition, remove all dead and dying limbs. Remove dead shrubs to the ground.

Note: We are letting our crepe myrtles and wax myrtles grow if/when they do not present safety or maintenance issues as outlined above or serve as building hedges.
