

PAVING PROJECT INFORMATION

Begins: **Tuesday, May 5th – Friday, May 8th, 2026**

Time: **7:30 AM – 7:30 PM Daily**

Phases: **1 – 4 (Subject to change)**

GOAL - Complete this PROJECT as quickly as possible.

Schedule to complete in 4 days – but will complete in 3 days if possible.

IMPORTANT TO KNOW - The Paving company will make your home & street accessible to ANY EMERGENCY VEHICLE(S).

- Phases are ONLY an outline for the project and are subject to CHANGE DAILY.
- If the crew can pave more than noted (in phase mapping), then they will.
- **REMEMBER THE GOAL!**
- **PLEASE BE FLEXIABLE** - IF you are in phase 2, 3, and 4 – you may be moved into the previous phase – if the paving crew can complete MORE than planned, they will. **REMEMBER THE GOAL!**
- **WE WILL HAVE A TOW TRUCK ON SITE – IF YOU ARE NOT AVAILABLE TO MOVE YOUR VEHICLHE - IT WILL BE MOVED BY A TOW TRUCK and you will be responsible for paying the fees associated with the move.**
- Delays can be caused by weather, equipment, and other things – this schedule is not etched in stone anywhere and is subject to change.

NEW ASPHALT LOVES THE SUN!!! PROTECT YOUR FUR BABIES PAWS AND BE MINDFUL THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER AS NEW PAVEMENT WILL BE HOTTER THAN THE OLD PAVEMENT.

What to be mindful about:

DUSTY, DIRTY, NOISY, VIBRATIONS, BUSY, FLYING DEBRIS

CARY PARKWAY ENTRANCE WILL BE BLOCKED FOR A COUPLE OF HOURS BEGINNING OF PROJECT ON TUESDAY MORNING. CONES WILL CLOSE OFF THIS ENTRANCE.

PARKING – relocate your vehicle in an area noted * on the phase maps.

Once striping is completed – you can move your vehicle back to your spot or location. Paint will dry within 15 minutes of striping.

A little information about what is happening:

Lots of equipment, and lots of moving parts all at one time.

- Milling Machine(s)
- Dump Truck(s) for Debris Collection
- Asphalt Truck(s) to bring asphalt
- Paving Machine to install new asphalt
- Specialized Rolling Machines (compactors)
- Striping – parking spaces

The project will begin with milling, where the top layer of existing asphalt (approximately 2–4 inches) is removed using specialized equipment. A DUMPTRUCK WILL be in front of the milling machine to collect the debris. There may be 2 to 3 dump trucks at a time lined up for this process. This process will create temporary noise, dust, and vibrations AND like a garbage disposal; there may be flying debris. **JUST BE MINDFUL!**

Paving will begin soon after the milling gets started, and the rolling comes right after pavement is installed. This process will continue throughout the day.

EXPECTATIONS

- Because of the unpredictable (flying debris) please don't use your driveway for parking when the paving crew/equipment is in your area.
- You can park in your garage.
- You can park in your driveway – but you will be responsible for any flying debris.
